

**Revolution Academy- 41Q
Return to Learn Plan**

Revolution Academy will continue its commitment to in-person learning for the 2021-22 school year. The RA board has voted to follow all applicable governmental directives. Therefore, as governmental directives change, the RA plan might change as well.

RA will offer in-person instruction on a full schedule with the following modifications for COVID-19:

MASKS – RA will abide by the Guilford County mask mandate and require students, staff members, and visitors to wear masks while inside the building, unless an exception exists.

QUARANTINING – RA will follow the quarantining requirements found in the Strong Schools Toolkit.

OTHER PROTOCOLS –

- Students will be kept in grade-level cohorts while inside the building, at lunch, and at recess.
- Students who ride the bus, where students cannot be separated by grade level, will be required to wear masks.
- Assemblies will be held outside, where virus spread is less likely.
- Students will be taught and encouraged to practice proper hand washing and sanitizing.
- The building will be aggressively cleaned daily.
- Visitors, volunteers, and lunch parents will be limited.
- Temperature screenings of all adults and students entering the building will be conducted.

INSTRUCTION

RA will offer in-person instruction exclusively, unless COVID quarantining makes it impossible for grade levels to attend in person. In those instances, virtual instruction will be used for those grade levels only.
