3. Begin preparing your speech & practice a few times in front of your family

  - a. Speeches should be 1-2 minutes long
  - b. Steer clear of promises you can't keep
    - i. OTHER SPEECH CONSIDERATIONS:
      1. Be sure to introduce yourself, tell us the office you are running for, and a few things about YOU that make you a strong candidate
      2. Share somethings about you that you may have participated in that show leadership or great character
